RENEWAL and MEMBERSHIP POLICY - Renewals and new membership applications can either be mailed to AMA's PO Box WITH a check or Money order <u>or</u> emailed to <u>atlanticmarksmen@gmail.com</u> with an Interac EMT to the same email address. Please use the password "AMAMBR2022" if you need to use a password. Make sure the name of who's renewing is in the EMT comments. Expect + or - 2 weeks for turnaround for cards. We do not process applications at the club. Again, please make sure the EMT is clear who the payment is for.

Remember that October is a very busy time for renewing our 300 members, so please be patient. We won't start checking memberships at the facilities until November.

MAINTENCE FEE FOR LATE RENEWAL. Be advised that after November 15th, there is a \$25 service fee to renew your membership late. Memberships received after midnight November 15th will not be processed unless accompanied by the \$25 fee. (SO PLEASE RENEW ON TIME!!!)

AMA Practice Nights - IPSC shooters -

Wednesday, October 13th will be the last outdoor time for IPSC. Wednesday nights indoor remain open to IPSC practice on Wednesday nights.

Steel plated, jacketed or steel core ammunition is prohibited at AMA's indoor range. This includes MFS ammunition. The Steel core stuff damages the backstop and the jacketed stuff causes sparks that could cause a fire in our facility. If you are in doubt about your ammunition, try touching it with a magnet in one of the ranges. If the magnet clings, it's a NO-GO. If you get caught shooting it indoors, you will likely lose your membership.

Range Rules - They are posted at the ranges so you cannot miss them. They are also included with this newsletter, as they have been for the past 24+ issues of the newsletter. Ignorance of the rules is not considered an excuse to violate them. These rules are for your safety and the safety of others. If you ignore these rules, not only do you jeopardize having the range closed, you jeopardize yours or someone else's life.

Guest Rules Are published with this newsletter as a reminder. They have been in effect for a long time. Please do not violate them.

COVID / Corona Virus. Basically, we are back up and running under the same schedule and level as we were pre-March. We ask that you social distance when at the range, if you feel ill – don't attend and please make use of the sanitizers and washing your hands. Masks are not

mandatory at AMA, but if you feel you want to wear one, go ahead. Note that some disciplines may ask for masks, they have that right. Check with the organizer.

Just a reminder that when you use the facilities, please throw your discarded brass, old targets, **coffee cups**, patch backers, etc. in the garbage cans and not on the range surface. When you use the indoor range, sweep up after yourself and when you're outdoors remember to **take down your old target**. It's no use to anyone after the rain gets on it the next day.

Another IPSC Black Badge Certification is planned for October 30/31 This course is the mandatory introductory course for anyone who wants to shoot IPSC (Action Pistol) in Canada

It teaches advanced handgun techniques; Safely surmounting obstacles, moving and shooting, drawing, changing sources of ammunition on the fly, weak hand shooting, strong hand shooting and various shooting

positions. It also teaches the fundamentals of the IPSC rules. Throughout, safety is foremost.

What is required to take the course?

- You must be able to hit an 8.5" by 11" piece of paper with every shot at a distance of 20 yards with no time limit.
- A center fire handgun; 9mm or bigger caliber. No Tokerovs.
- A holster that protects the trigger guard of the gun. (so you can't touch the trigger while it is holstered) No Serpa, no tie-down rigs
- At least 2 magazines or speed loaders and pouches to hold them - but the more you have; the easier it is for you.
- 400 rounds of ammunition no raw lead & no steel.
 Reloads MUST work well in your gun.
- Eye and ear protection.
- \$200.00, includes entry to your first two matches.
- Ability to attend all day Saturday and Sunday. Arrive at the course with an open book test complete.

What do you get in return?

- Ability to Shoot in IPSC matches (15 will be held in Nova Scotia this year around the province - hundreds throughout the country)
- Engraved Black badge pin (after shooting in your first match)
- IPSC Rule book.
- Membership in IPSC Nova Scotia until January 2022.
- Membership in IPSC Canada until January 2022.
- Membership in IPSC until January 2022.
- An intimate knowledge of using a full power firearm safely and quickly.

Please contact Sean Hansen (contact info elsewhere) should you be interested in taking the course.

Classes are limited to 12 participants.

RIFLE RANGE: Please note that Only the three left-most firing positions in the rifle range building can be used for shooting at the 100m firing point. The 280m firing point can be shot from any position.

Smoking. There is NO smoking in the indoor range. Smoking is only permitted in the parking lots at the outdoor range. **This includes vaping.**
