Time to Renew Your Membership!!!

Once again it's that time of the year to renew your membership in the A.M.A. Your invoice should be enclosed with this newsletter. If the amount is not correct (i.e. didn't get a family rate, etc.) please send an explanation along with your remittance. If a junior has turned 18 before the end of September they are now a senior and would pay half the senior rate. The family rates apply only to spouses and sons or daughters living at home. Please put your invoice # on your cheque or money order.

- If you've already paid, just disregard the invoice.
- If the value on the invoice is incorrect for you, please send the correct amount and make a note with it.

RENEWAL and MEMBERSHIP POLICY - Renewals and new membership applications can either be mailed to AMA's PO Box WITH a check or Money order or emailed to atlanticmarksmen@gmail.com with an **Interac EMT** to the same email address. Please use the password **"AMAMBR2026"** if you need to use a password. **Make sure the name of who's renewing is in the EMT comments.** Expect + or - 2 weeks for turnaround for cards. We do not process applications at the club. Again, please make sure the EMT is clear who the payment is for.

Remember that October is a very busy time for renewing our 300 members, so please be patient. We won't start checking memberships at the facilities until December.

MAINTENCE FEE FOR LATE RENEWAL. Be advised that after December 15th, there is a \$25 service fee to renew your membership late. Memberships received after midnight December 15th will not be processed unless accompanied by the \$25 fee. **(SO PLEASE RENEW ON TIME!!!)**

AMA updates – you MUST have an email address on file to receive updates about the indoor and outdoor ranges. Not getting notice because you don't have an email address is not and excuse the board will accept anymore.

General Shooting moves back inside for Fall / Winter - As of October 4th, Saturday General Shooting will be held at the indoor range, starting at 1 PM.

Steel plated, jacketed or steel core ammunition is prohibited at AMA's indoor range. This includes **MFS ammunition.** The Steel core stuff damages the backstop and the jacketed stuff causes sparks that could cause a fire in our facility. If you are in doubt about your ammunition, try touching it with a magnet in one of the ranges. If the magnet clings, it's a **NO-GO.** **If you get caught shooting it indoors, you will likely lose your membership.**

Shotgun Range. Keys for the Shotgun Range have been changed out with a combination lock. The combination is the same as the AMA container. If you don't know it and are a current RO with keys, just email the handgun chair (andrewbrace6@hotmail.com) and he will let you know it.

- **Tuesday Evenings** - General Handgun. All members are welcome. The format is the standard distance from the tables. Begin at 6:30 PM
- **Wednesday Evenings**- IPSC Shooting. **Black Badge Holders** beginning at 5:00 PM.
- **Thursday Evenings** - ISU Practice Night, Begin at 6:30 PM
- **Saturday Afternoon** - General Handgun. All members are welcome. The format is the standard distance from the tables. 1 PM – 4 PM (*or until no one is left shooting – don't show up at 3:30 and expect to get much shooting done*)
- **Sunday**. IPSC Practice – 8:30 AM to 5 PM. Range Officer members may also use the range at this time but must defer to IPSC Shooters for range use if they show up.

Outdoors:

- **Sunday Morning** – Rifle Shooting in the Rifle Range. Begin at 10.
